SEPARATION ANXIETY

Babies usually start expressing separation anxiety between 6 and 9 months of age. Of course this varies with each individual child. This developmental stage can be trying, but is a milestone with their emotional development. Here are some tips to ease into the process of separation.

- 1) Start out slow by leaving your child for short periods of time with someone you can trust. Start with a family member, or friend, or a trustworthy caretaker. Gradually increase the timeframe you are away from your baby, as well as letting your baby gradually adjust to new environments.
- 2) Plan on leaving while they are awake. Remember your child will sense if you are anxious so take a deep breath, and let them see that you are confident, and reassure them that you will be back soon.
- 3) Having your child keep a special toy or blanket with them will also give them a sense of security.
- 4) Remember this stage is a positive way of your baby showing healthy attachment to you. Ultimately know that your child will adjust, and the stage of separation anxiety will ease with time for you and your baby!
