IDEA CORNER:

ROUTINES AND PLAY

With our Arizona weather we are so lucky it's a great time for some outdoor play and routines you can integrate into your day.

Sensory: Have your child feel the different textures around your yard or in a park. Let him/her have their hands and feet in the grass and dirt. Talk about the different sounds and textures (wind, plants, grass, leaves etc.)

Literacy: Name everything you hear outside, and touch and explore your surroundings. You can encourage your child to engage in sound play with you. Shake your keys, sing and interact with finger plays

Visual motor: Let your child scribble on the sidewalk with chalk or washable paint. It is a great way to play and use eye hand coordination.

Social: Have your child interact with you or a sibling by rolling a ball back and forth in the grass, or on the pavement.

Just remember helping your child develop happens best when you integrate everything into your everyday experiences. Learning takes place best through routines

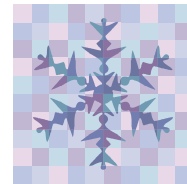

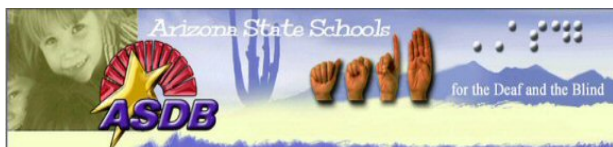

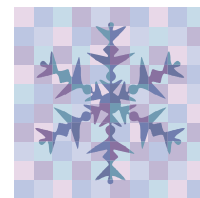
