

March 21st is the first day of spring! **Sensory:** Nature walk-smell, touch and explore trees, leaves, and grass **Visual motor:** point out and have child reach for flowers, and play with dirt **Literacy:** imitate the sounds made by birds, and other animals. Also talk about the temperature. "How does the sun feel shining on you?" "Do you feel the wind blowing in your hair?" **Independence:** Let your child move about outdoors by touching grass while playing on their tummy, or by crawling, or walking and exploring the outdoor environment. Also remember to let your child help choose what to wear before going outside. Let them touch their shoes, feel and touch different textures of their hats and clothes. Let them choose between two items-they will learn that their choices count!

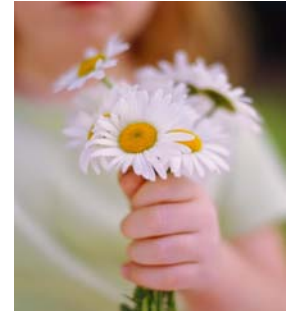
